### A report from Raewyn on the Family Camp and Synod

Have you ever suffered from the regret that the faith we share is not followed by our children? Bishop Ellie, while she was here introduced the vision for Leaders' Family Camps based on her experience as a child. She found that the church kept taking her father away from the family for Clergy Conferences and other events and her Mum and the children had to be without him and began to resent the church and God. Her dream was to have a camp for leaders and their families so that family camps were to BUILD families and their relationship with God. Family members would grow friendships with others the same age and the WHOLE FAMILY would want to reconnect at the next family camp, or INDIVIDUAL leaders with other leaders who built networks and supported each other in their ministries. These camps have gone from strength to strength. A fortnight ago Odette, Ali and I attended the Diocesan Leader's Family Camp. It was just what I needed. Odette helped out in the children's programme for this camp and thoroughly enjoyed it.

The next family camp is in March 2023 and I encourage our leaders to go and take their families if they have them.

Recently Ali and I also attended Synod. I thoroughly enjoyed both events and was left with a sense of awe and encouragement about where the Diocese of Wellington is heading. The vitality and energy in both events was amazing. There were so many young families and their children. The Leaders' Family Camp had 2 excellent speakers from overseas Rev.
