Younger children will be able to attend, especially if they are siblings that need to be cared for by their older brother or sister. There will be a focus on fun, kinaesthetic and tactile learning eg cooking and measuring, skipping things that

need to be memorised, fun quizzes and competitions, whatever seems appropriate, with the student at the centre of our thinking. If you would like to help in anyway with this outreach please contact Raewyn. You do not need to be a teacher! There are many other useful roles.
