We cry out to you in the midst of this pain and trauma of violence and fear which prevails in the Holy Land. Be with those who need you in these

days of suffering. We pray for people of all faiths - Jews, Muslims and Christians - and for all peo-

ple of the land.

We pray, O Lord, for an end to violence and the establishment of peace. We call for you to bring justice and equity to the peoples.

Guide us into your kingdom where all people are treated with dignity and honour as your children - for to all of us you are our Heavenly Father. Amen.
