Upcoming Diocesan Events:

This year marks the 10th year of Thy Kingdom Come - a global ecumenical prayer movement that invites Christians worldwide to pray from Ascension to Pentecost for people to know Jesus. As we pray to Pentecost, we have three simple but meaningful ways to engage: prayer walking, praying for five, and running a prayer vigil.

Pray the Streets with the Holy Ground

App. From Easter to Pentecost parishes are invited to join a season of intentional intercession to invite God's transformation of our communities, through prayer-walking and the Holy Ground App.

Praying for five people to come to know the joy and freedom of Jesus. To help you identify your people, you might like to ask yourself:

- Who are the people who are friendly and curious about how I live my faith?
- Who are the people who just keep popping into my head?
- Have I had any surprise encounters with people recently?
- Who in my family could I pray for?
 Either join together with others or pray alone.

On Sunday, 25 May at 5 pm, the invitation is to gather—on hilltops, mountain summits, high ground, or significant places of whenua—to worship and pray for our tamariki (children) and rangatahi (young people). This event, simply called "A Call to Pray".
