Notice of St John's Trentham church AGM

being held in the St John's Trentham church hall on Sunday 3 May at 12 noon.

Business matters: New business matters cannot be raised from the floor on the day of the AGM. Please provide our Vicars' Warden with written notice of any business items for the Agenda, with a brief description of the issue, by 19 April.

Motions: Are there any motions for voting on at this year's AGM? Motions need to be received and advertised prior to the AGM; they cannot be raised on the day of the AGM. Please provide these to the Vicars' Warden by 19 April.

Governance: Near the end of the AGM there will be elections for the positions of Vestry (3-10 elected lay members), Synod Representative, and Wardens. These valued volunteers oversee the operational decisions, accounts, spending, and health and safety of this church.

Candidates for Vestry must be nominated and seconded by someone on the

parish electoral roll and must give their consent to stand. Nomination forms can be obtained from Kate.

Nominees need to be on the parish electoral roll and be prepared to sign a declaration acknowledging the authority of General Synod/Te Hīnota Whānui. Vestry may meet monthly or every second month. Vestry currently meets on the second or third Sunday of a month at 4pm.

Voters need to ensure their names are on the Trentham parish electoral roll. To be on this roll, people need to be baptised believers who have participated in the worship and life of this parish for at least four months. If you're not sure if you're on the roll yet, please see [the People's Warden] to check the roll or to apply to be on the roll prior to the AGM.

An AGM booklet, containing reports on activities and finances through 2025, is being prepared for distribution at the AGM.
